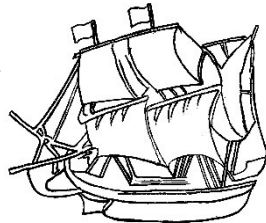


YOUR NAME

Write the letter in the box

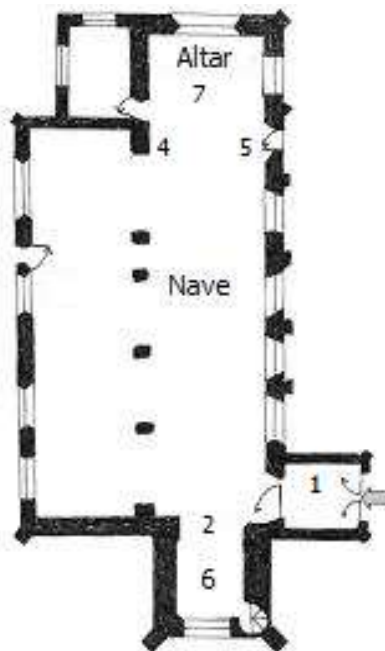


3 NAVE

6 ROPES

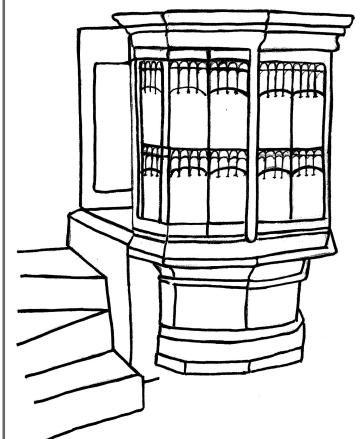
Now turn around and look at the back of the church above the font. What do you think the ropes are used for?

4 LECTERN

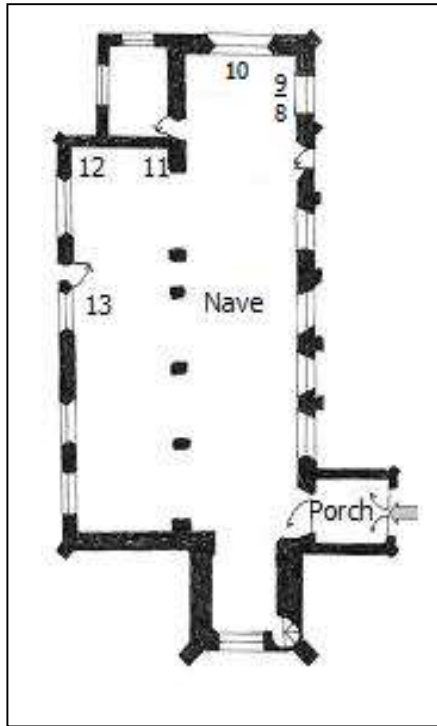
What is the name of the large book on the lectern?

12 THE MAYFLOWER PAINTING

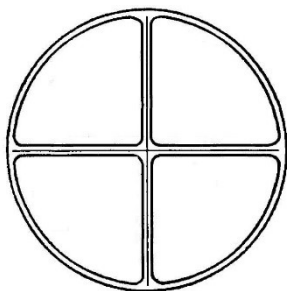
Look to your left on the north wall. What church is shown in the background of the picture?
