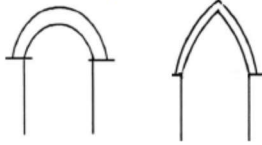

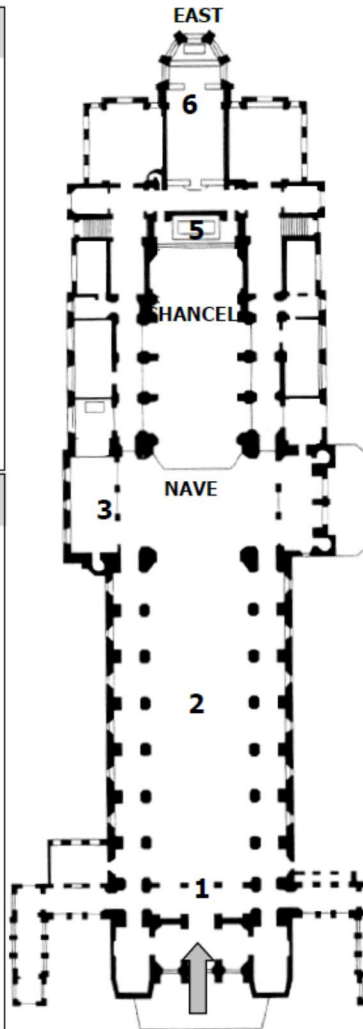

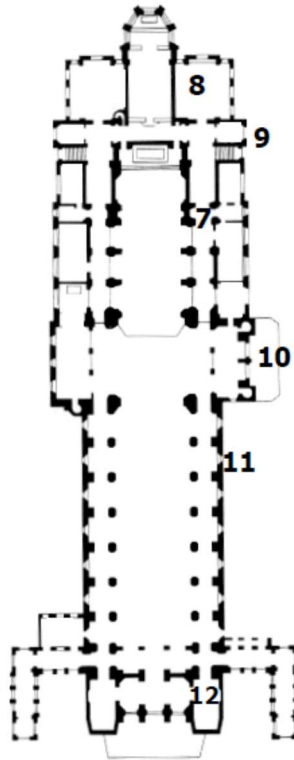


7 BISHOP'S CHAIR

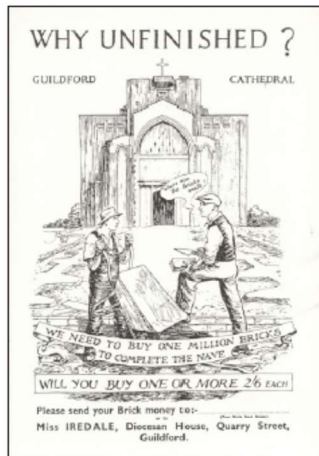

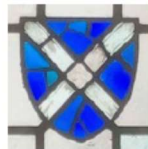
