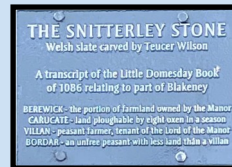

From the Quay (**10** on the trail) boats set sail  
in Medieval times for Iceland in the Spring to  
catch fish to salt and bring back to sell to  
Royalty in the Autumn.

and the tunnels said to lie  
under the village
