INTRODUCTION

St George's Church was consecrated in 1731.

It is a masterpiece of Late Baroque architecture. And one of the finest 18th Century churches in England.

The spire is unusual, being a stepped pyramid shape topped by a statue of George I and supported by two lions and two unicorns,

1 FIRST IMPRESSIONS

Stand here for a moment and look across the church. What do you notice?

Are there any smells or sensations that come to mind, for example is it cold, damp, musty; can you smell flowers?

Look at the magnificent chandelier - have you been

3 NAVE



Let's walk across the church and stop in the middle to have a look around. What do you notice most the windows, perhaps, or the columns, the stone carvings and the plasterwork? Tell us what you can see from here.

5 PULPIT

Share your thoughts on who would use this and what they would do from here.

Touch the pulpit - what is it made of and what does it feel like?

Do you remember sitting and listening to very long talks from the person standing in the pulpit?



2 FONT



Spend a few minutes here and share what you notice. For example, what is it made of, what does it feel like?

Talk about what would happen here and any thoughts on who would do what. Do you have memories of family christenings?

4 ALTAR

Look at this ornate altar, what catches your eye. Maybe the embroidered altar cloth. Have you ever done embroidery or crochet?

What happens here at the altar? For example, communion, wedding ceremonies. Do you have memories of these?


6 ICON
